

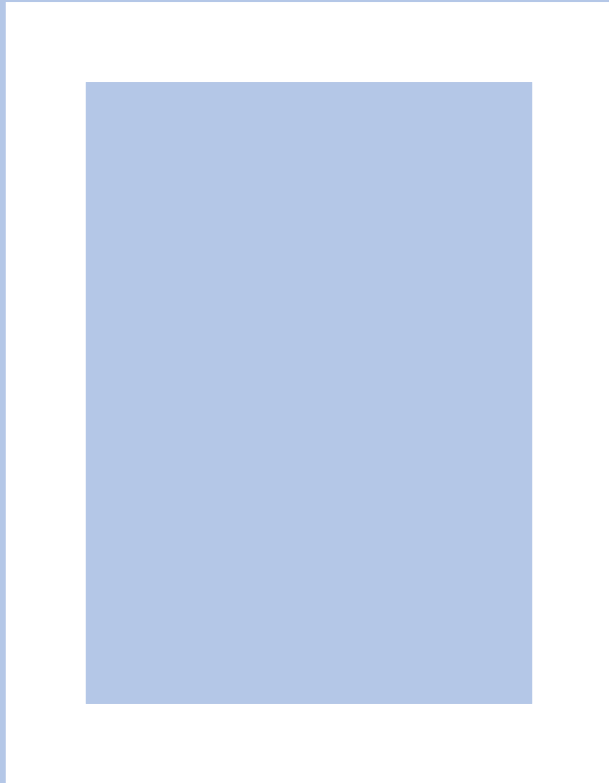
Measuring Your Curtains

The Anna Louisa Interiors guide to measuring for your made-to-measure curtains.

This is a super simple process and all you need is a pencil and measuring tape.



Straight Pole



Width

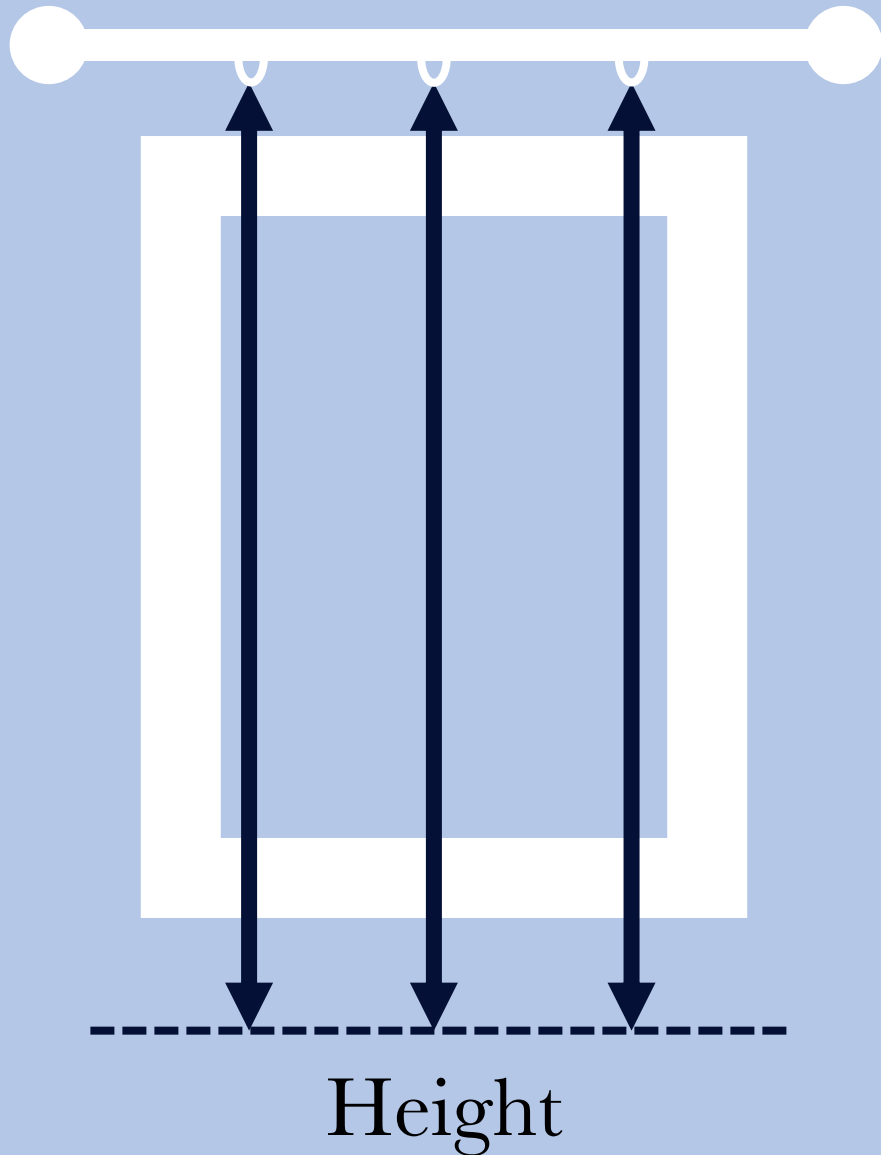
Step 1: Width

1. Using a tape measure, measure the width of the pole excluding the finials at the end.

Note: please provide this exact measurement as we will calculate the necessary requirements to ensure an overlap in the middle and returns on the side.



Straight Pole



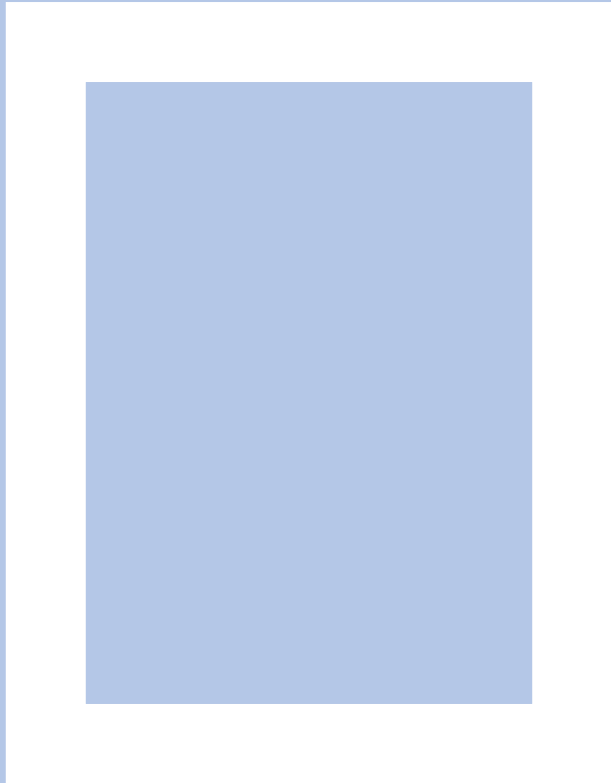
Step 2: Height

1. Measure from the bottom of the hook to the desired drop.
2. Complete this measurement in three places; the left, middle, and right and take the smallest of these three.

Note: make sure to take into consideration whether your window sill protrudes and intrudes with the curtains if you are going for full length curtains.



Straight Track



Width

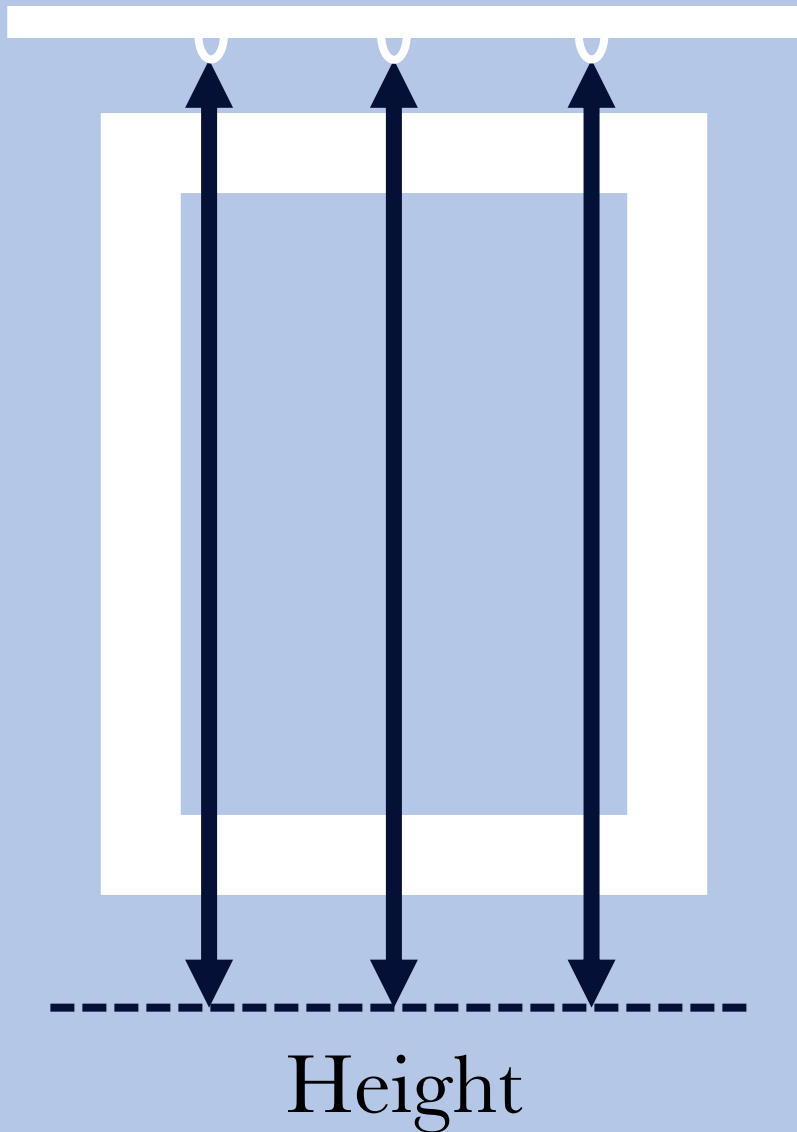
Step 1: Width

1. Using a tape measure, measure the width of the entire track.

Note: please provide this exact measurement as we will calculate the necessary requirements to ensure an overlap in the middle and returns on the side.

Step 2: Height

1. Measure from the bottom of the hook to the desired drop.
2. Complete this measurement in three places; the left, middle, and right and take the smallest of these three.

Note: make sure to take into consideration whether your window sill protrudes and intrudes with the curtains if you are going for full length curtains.
